

2017 Chateau Sainte Eulalie Minervois la Liviniere Grand Vin

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Drawn from the estate's oldest vines, the 2017 Minervois la Liviniere Grand Vin is 55% Syrah (30+-year-old vines), 25% Carignan (84+-year-old vines, including some over 100) and 20% Grenache (70+-year-old vines), aged in epoxy-lined tanks for eight months. The old vines do seem to give the wine greater depth and richness than the estate's other cuvées, adding a layer of earthy depth to the plum and blackberry fruit. The wine is full-bodied and velvety in texture, with a lingering finish of star anise and cracked pepper. Producer: Sainte Eulalie, Chateau
